
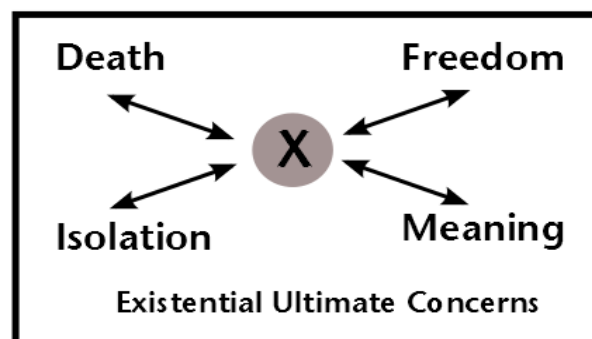

 <p style="text-align: center;">Maslow Needs Hierarchy</p>	<p>Power is the desire to influence others. Independence is the desire for self-reliance. Curiosity is the desire for knowledge. Acceptance is the desire for inclusion. Order is the desire for organization. Saving is the desire to collect things. Honor is the desire to be loyal to one's parents and heritage. Idealism is the desire for social justice. Social Contact is the desire for companionship. Family is the desire to raise one's own children. Status is the desire for social standing. Vengeance is the desire to get even. Romance is the desire for sex and beauty. Eating is the desire to consume food. Physical Activity is the desire for exercise of muscles.
